CaseFiles integrates with Canvas from rostering to grade sync:

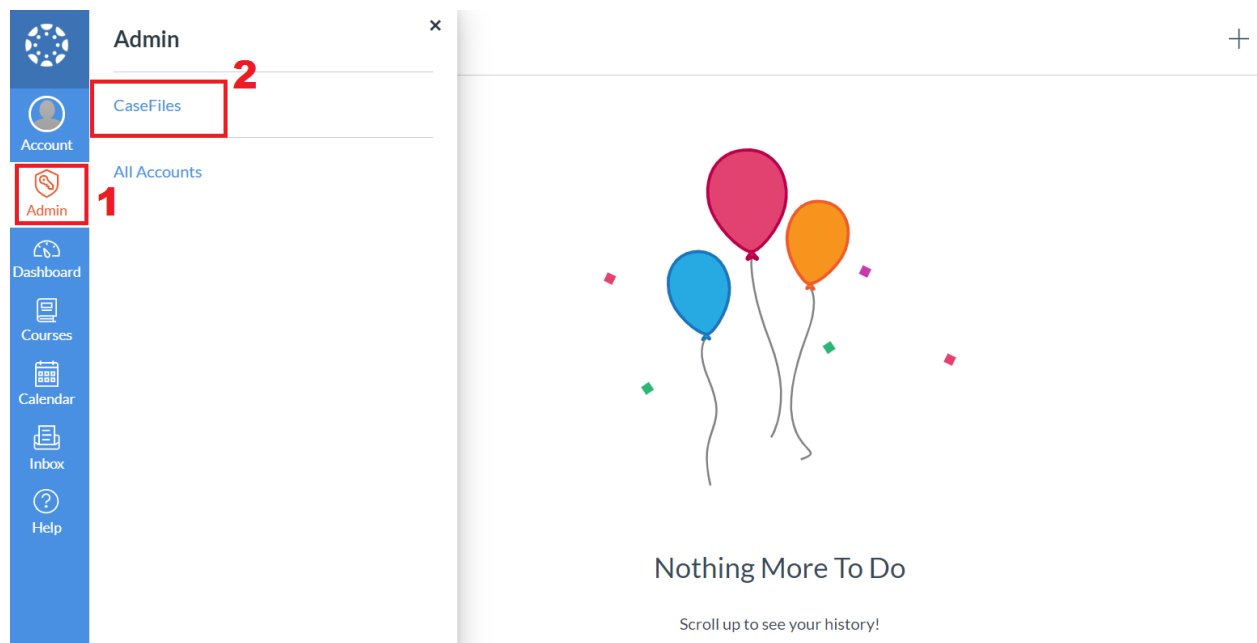
Step #1 Install CaseFiles SSO app in your Canvas instance

Step #2 Obtain Developer Key to Integrate Canvas with CaseFiles

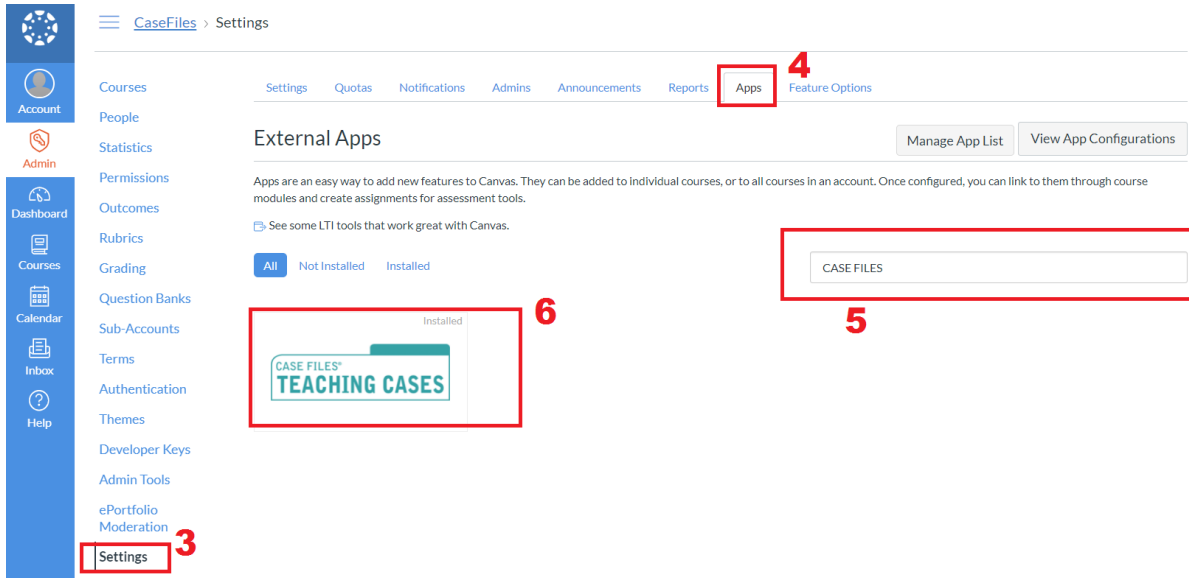
Step # 3 CaseFiles tech support completes integration of CaseFiles with your Canvas instance

Step #1 Install CaseFiles SSO app in your Canvas instance

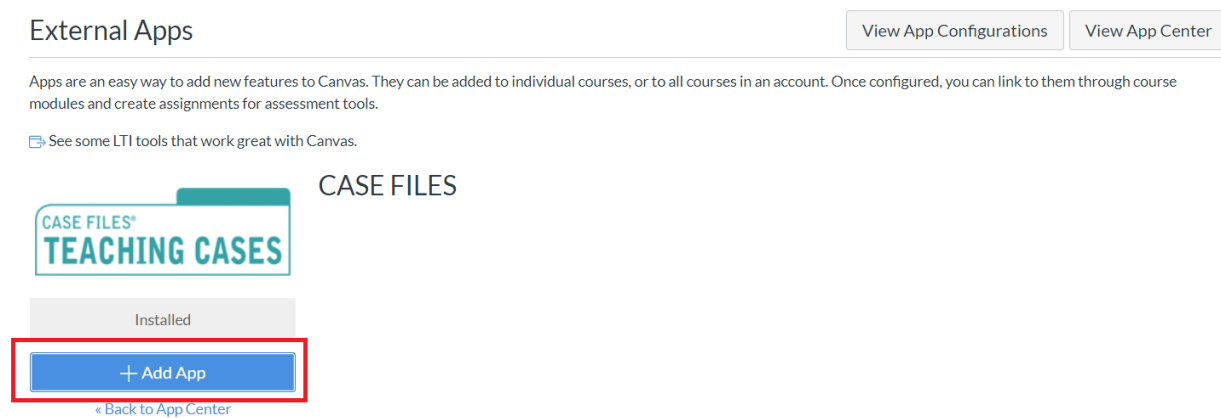
1. Log-in as admin to Canvas instance
2. Click on Admin and click on instance defined in Managed Accounts



3. Go to Settings > Apps > Search for “CaseFiles” and click on the App

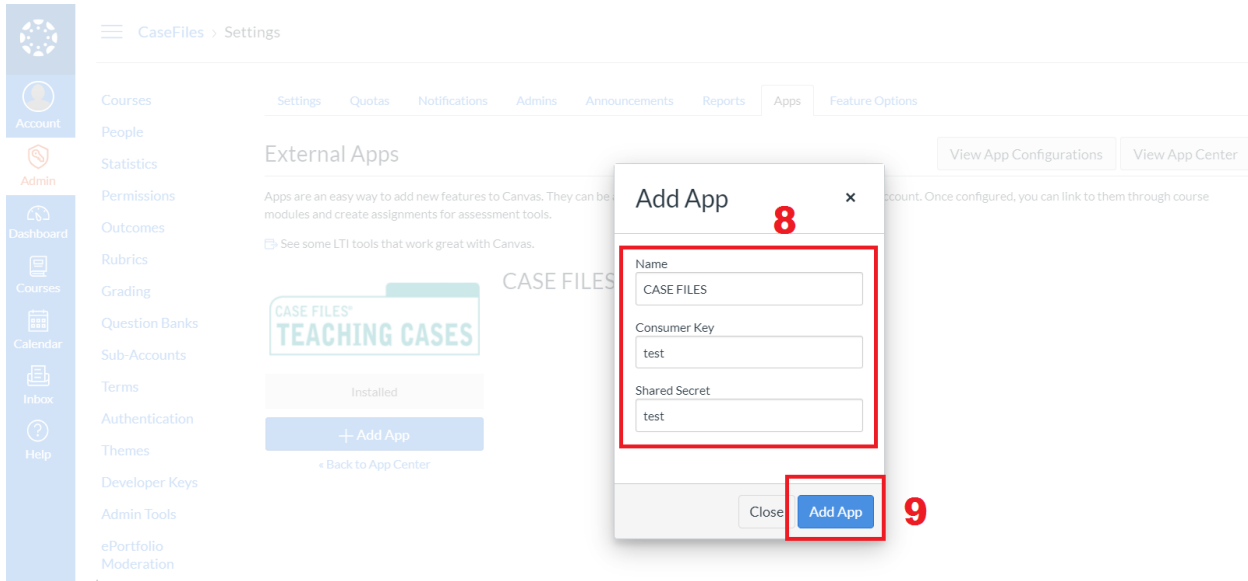


4. Click on +Add App

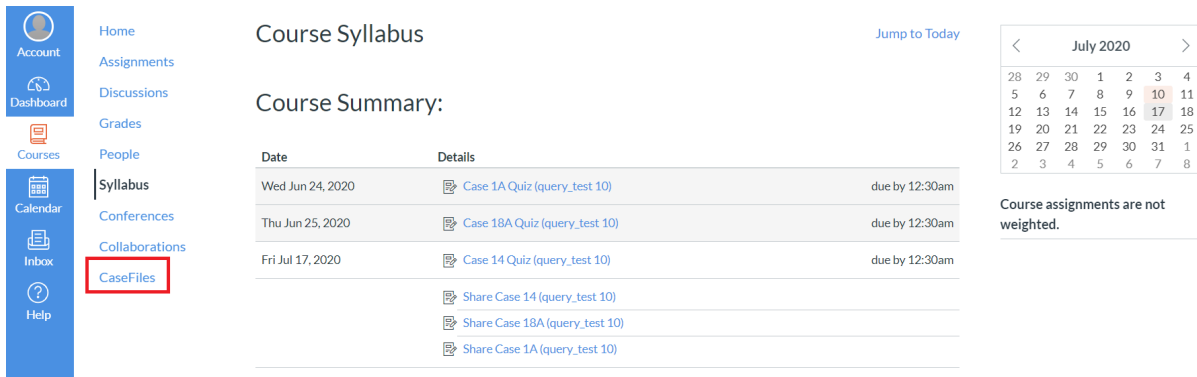


5. Enter Consumer Key and Shared Secret provided below and click on + Add App

1. Name should be **CaseFiles** (This will be visible as a link to users)
2. consumer key: **McGrawHill**
3. shared secret: **McGrawHill**



6. Go to the Canvas course as either a teacher or a student and verify the link

Step #3 CaseFiles tech support completes integration of CaseFiles with your Canvas instance


CaseFiles tech support team will complete the configuration on CaseFiles site before the integration is complete. Once the integration is configured, it is possible to link CaseFiles within Canvas as a Canvas single sign-on (SSO) application.

FAQ

Our integration is complete. How do we ensure teachers and students start using CaseFiles?

Once the integration is complete, teachers and CaseFiles can access CaseFiles using the SSO link. Instructors can also sync their class enrollment, post assignment to Canvas and finally sync the grades.

#1 - Create CaseFiles Account: Teachers will have one-click access to CaseFiles using the Course side navigation as shown below.

For those teachers **with** an existing CaseFiles account, please make sure that your username in CaseFiles and Canvas are the same. (ie. john.doe@canvas.org is the same login for your Canvas account AND CaseFiles account)

For those teachers **without** an existing CaseFiles account, a brand new account will be auto-provisioned in CaseFiles once you login to Canvas and go through the SSO link as shown above. Teachers will be asked to provide some details about their school before their Canvas classes are imported:

#3 - Sync Canvas courses with CaseFiles

Next CaseFiles would prompt you to select the courses (only published courses) and sections that you need to be synced with Canvas.

Once this is done, CaseFiles creates a class section and automatically enrolls students in the class section based on the Canvas information. If student accounts do not exist in CaseFiles, the student accounts will get created in CaseFiles as well.

#4 Sync Assignments in CaseFiles - CaseFiles will automatically post the assignment to Canvas when assessment is assigned.

#5 One click access to assessment - Students can simply click on the assignment in Canvas and take the assessment in CaseFiles.

#6 Grade sync - Once all students have submitted the assessment and their responses are graded, the grades will be automatically synced with Canvas.

I have sections in my Canvas course. How will that be handled?

CaseFiles will create individual class sections for each of your Canvas class sections.

Please ensure that courses are published in Canvas. Only courses that are published can be synced.
