

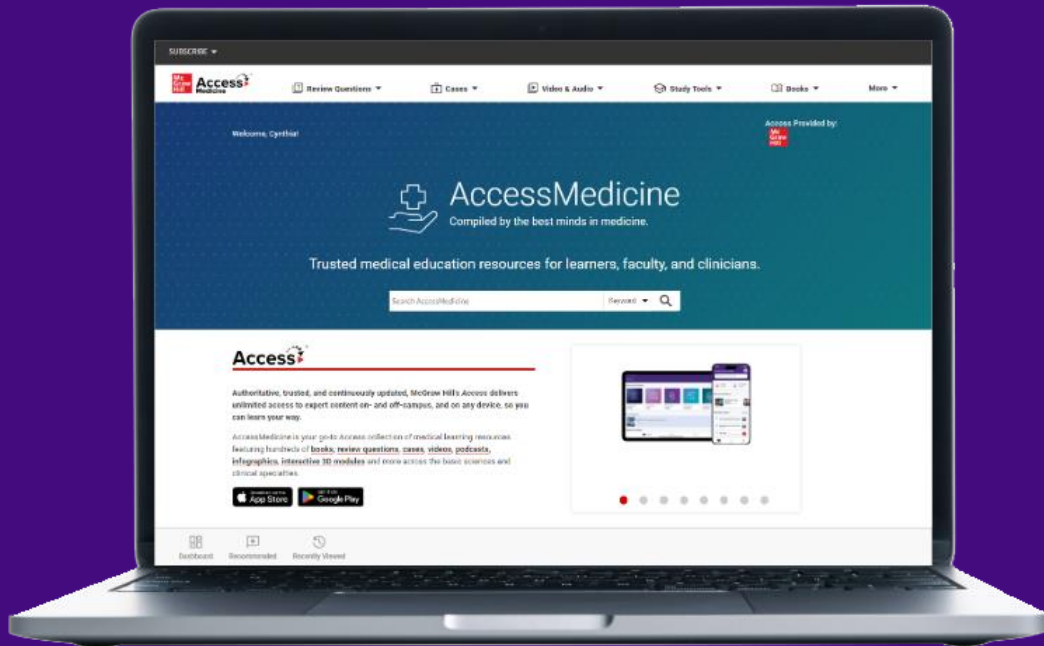

About the Access® UI Update



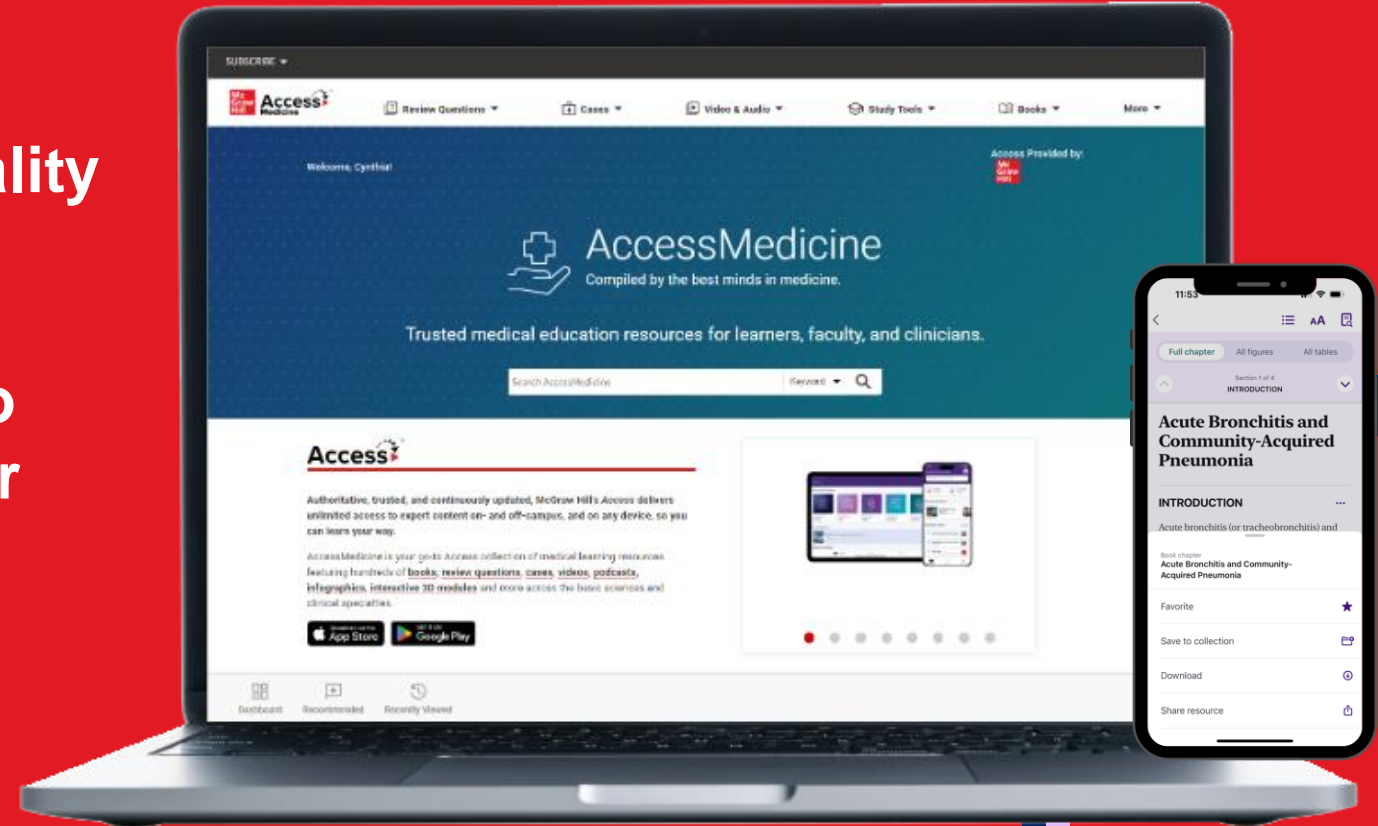
- This **is** an enhancement to design and some functionality to better showcase our **existing content and features**.
