
How to Change Your Institution in MyAccess Remotely


Suppose you are affiliated with NYU College of Nursing, but you need to change your institution to Emory University. You are trying to access Emory University's subscriptions, and not NYU's subscriptions. How do you do this? How do you change your institution affiliation?

Follow the steps below to affiliate your MyAccess profile with a new institution. The screenshots below demonstrate an example using NYU and Emory. Please adapt according to your institutional affiliation(s).

1. Log in to your MyAccess account on one of our sites (AccessMedicine in the examples below) and sign in on the upper righthand corner.






2. Notice your name in the upper righthand corner and the institution with which you are currently affiliated.




3. Open a tab to connect to the institution with which you need to be affiliated. You can often go directly to that institution's library list of databases and click on our site (AccessMedicine)




4. You may be prompted to log in to the institution:




5. Once logged in/connected to your institution, you should see the new affiliation in the upper righthand corner of AccessMedicine (Emory University). However, you are still not signed in to your MyAccess profile, and therefore not linked with the new institution. Click the "Sign in" button in the upper righthand corner.




6. Sign in to your MyAccess profile.





7. Your name or MyAccess profile is now affiliated with the new institution. Now any time you sign in with your MyAccess username and password, the institution you see to the right of your name will be the most recent institution with which you affiliated (from steps 3-6).
