

2025 Burnett Scholarship for DICE MSc For applicants from the KAZA region

The [Durrell Institute of Conservation and Ecology](#) (DICE) at the University of Kent is pleased to announce the inaugural Burnett Scholarship scheme for **2025/6** for the **DICE Masters' course for applicants from Angola, Botswana, Namibia, Zambia and Zimbabwe**. Through the generosity of the Notsew Orm Sands Foundation, we are offering up to six scholarships this year, and next year.

The successful applicants will each receive a fully funded studentship on our taught [MSc in Conservation Science](#).

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be nationals of, or have official refugee status in, Angola, Botswana, Namibia, Zambia or Zimbabwe.
- Have at least two years of work experience in the conservation sector.
- Be in possession of a good undergraduate degree, with a minimum of a UK 2:1 or equivalent.
- Meet the [UK Visas and Immigration](#) specifications and [University of Kent English language requirements](#).

Scholarship Details

The Scholarship covers full tuition fees, a monthly stipend and travel expenses to and from the UK. The scholarship is for the Taught Master's course offered at DICE in Conservation Science starting in September 2025.
