

NEUROTYPICAL

Brains that function **like the majority** of people are said to be **neurotypical**

NEURODIVERGENCE

Any brain that functions **differently** from the neurotypical is **neurodivergent**

NEURODIVERSE

A broad range of groups containing both **neurotypical** people and **neurodivergent** people is **neurodiverse**

NEURODIVERSITY

The **whole range** of human brains, every brain is **unique**, but no **one** brain can be neurodiverse

NEURODIVERSITY MOVEMENT

The disability rights movement fighting for **acceptance** and **inclusion** for people with neurological differences

NEURODIVERSITY PARADIGM

The idea that all brains have **equal value**, and that differences in **neurology** and **physiology** contain both strengths and weaknesses, and that there's no such thing as a "normal" brain

NEURODIVERGENCE AFFIRMING

The use of language that is both affirming and accepting of different ways of **thinking**, **learning** and **behaving**
