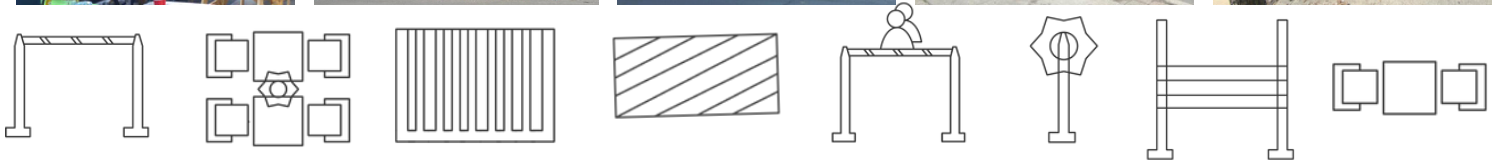
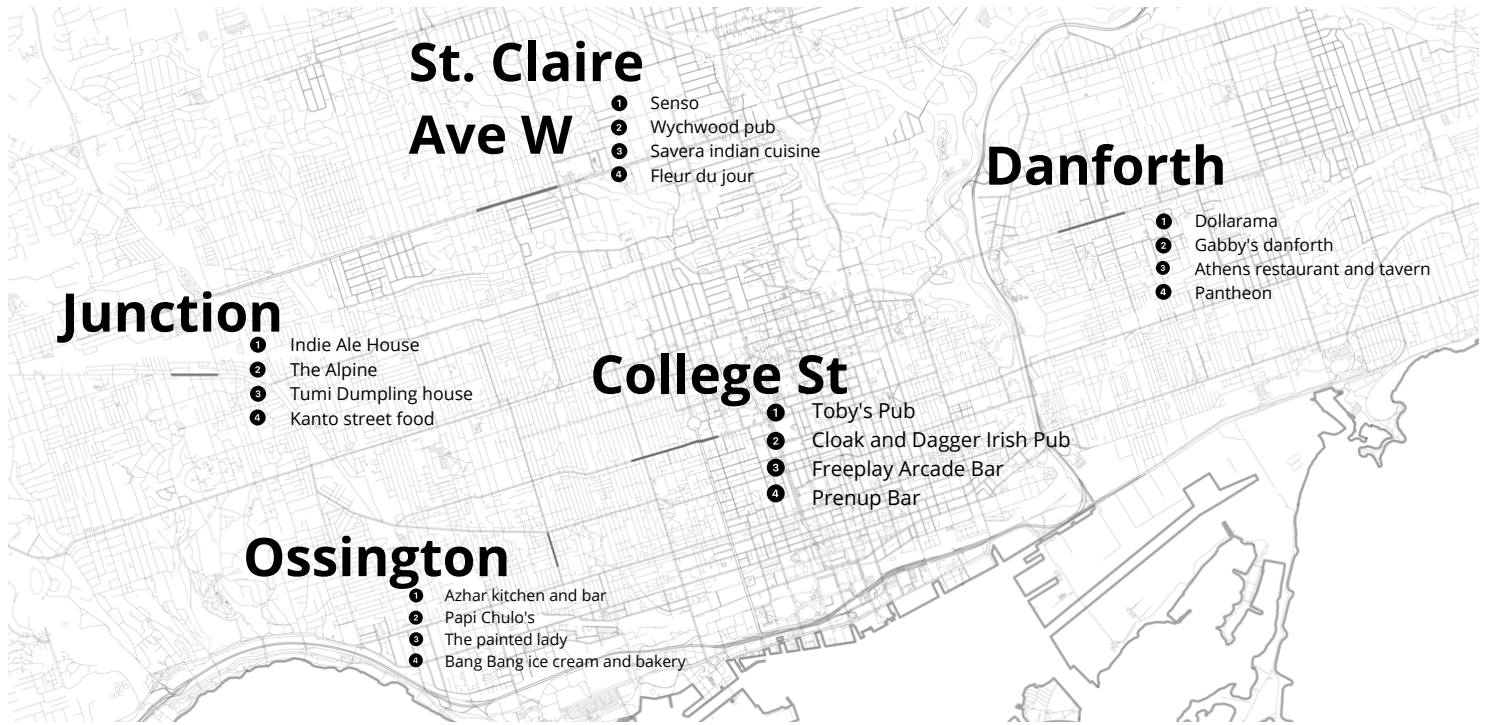


Public Spaces Post Pandemic: Comparative and Typological Analysis of Curb Lane Cafés Downtown Toronto
