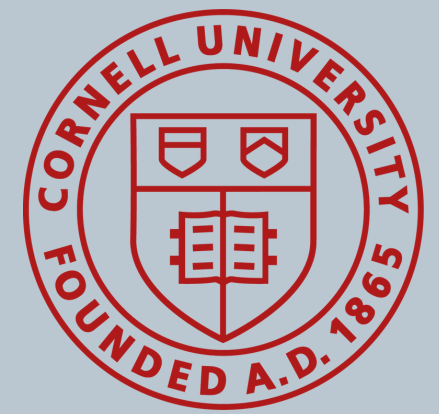


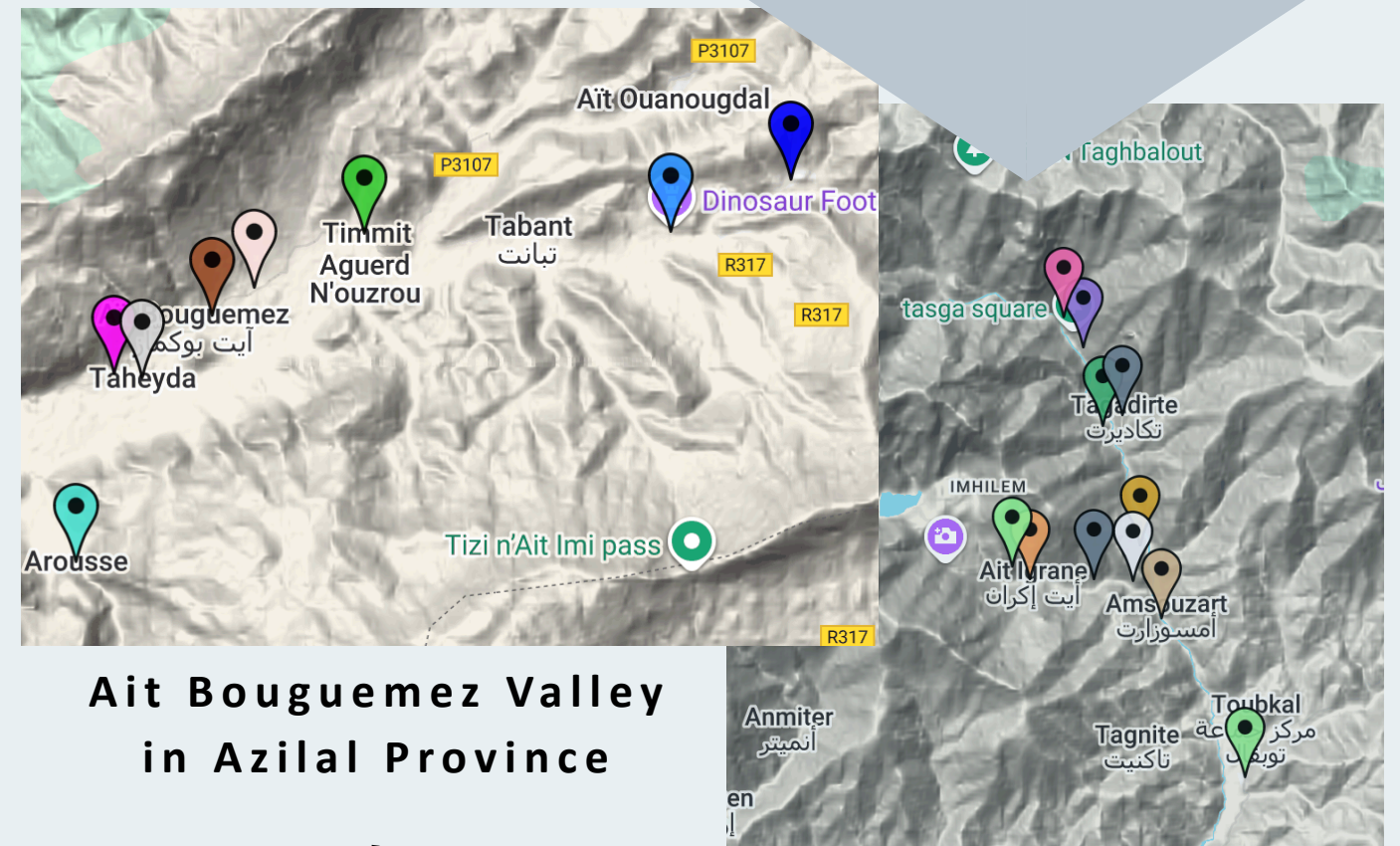
# LiA: Agricultural Development Policy Fieldwork In High Atlas Mountains of Morocco

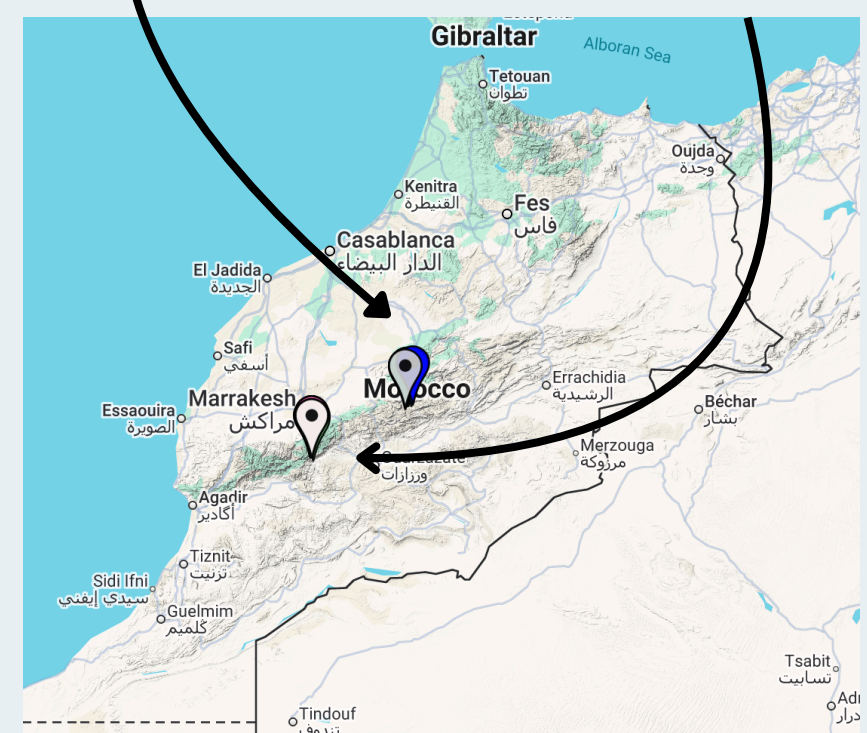
## GOALS & OBJECTIVES

- During the school year: Systematic literature review of Plan Maroc Vert and Génération Green 2020-2030, independent literature review on decentralization, neopatrimonialism, and participatory processes
- Fieldwork aims: Understand how government satisfaction (access to aid, perceptions, understanding of development policies) shapes political participation
- Objectives: Design and conduct IRB-approved interviews with community members and local political figures in Toubkal and Ait Bouguemez, work with translators to translate from English > French > Tashelhit

## OUTCOMES

- Completed over 80 individual interviews across 20 villages and four focus groups with members of cooperatives
