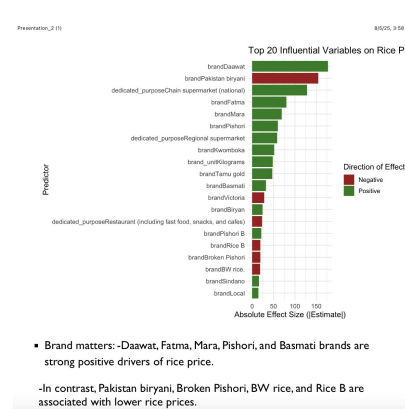
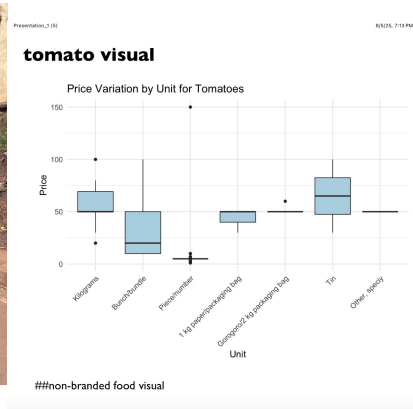
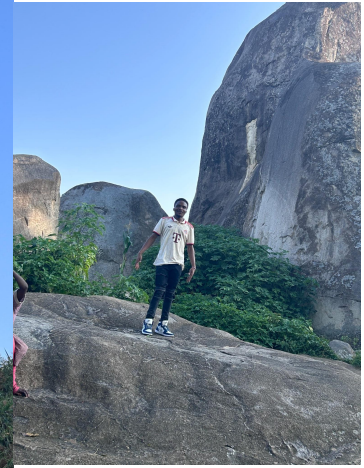


Two Secondary Cities in Kenya

Abstract

This study focuses on developing an External Food Environment Surveillance System (EFESS) to monitor temporal and spatial variations in food environments, specifically targeting informal and formal food vendors in Kirinyaga and Machakos, Kenya.
