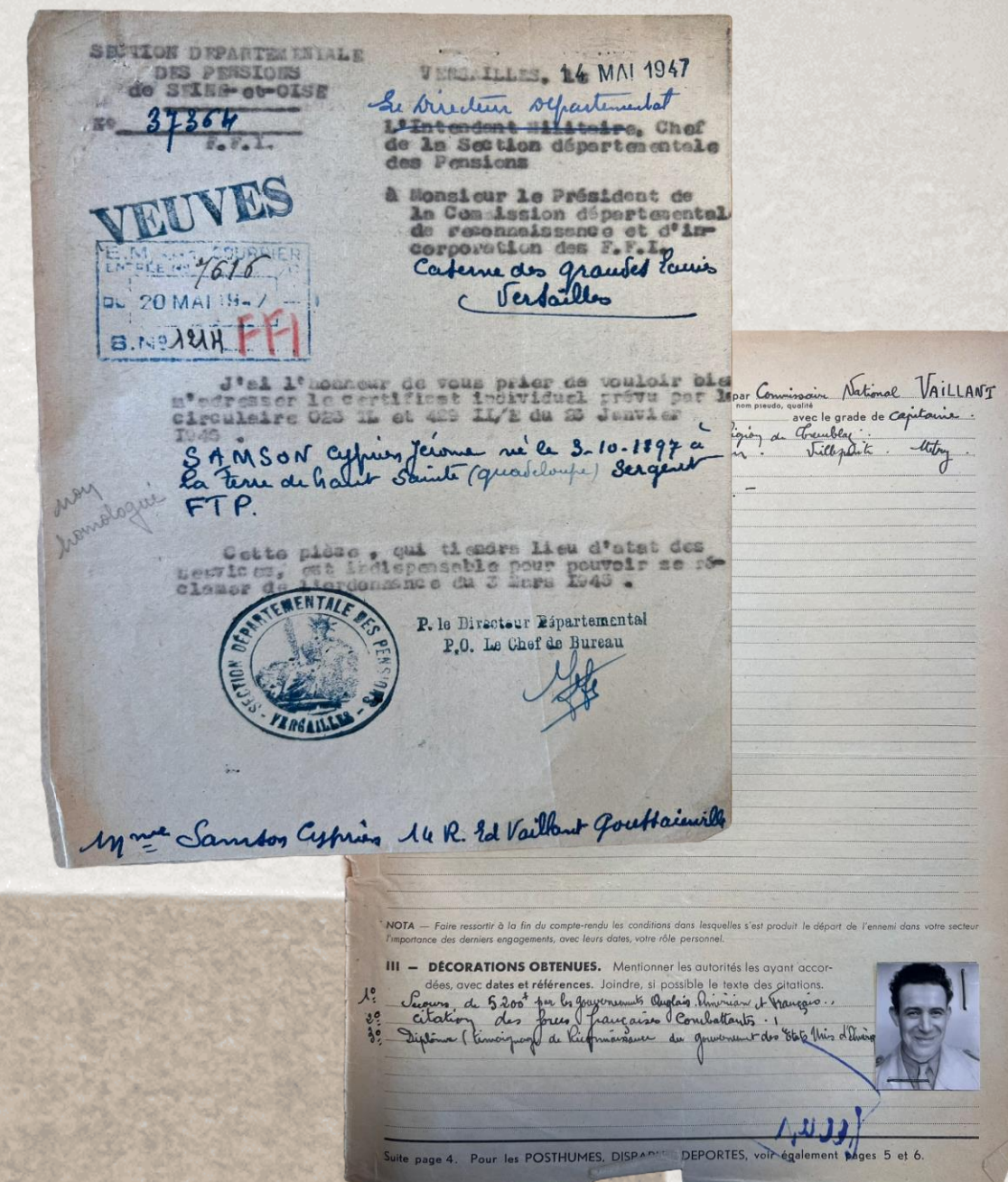


**DISCUSSION & FINDINGS:**
