"While we cannot predict future changes to U.S. trade policy, Mimo has steadily increased the number of lines we manufacture in Korea and the rest have been moved to Taiwan," said David Anderson, president and CEO of Mimo. "In addition to gaining an advantage in regulated markets, Mimo's catalog is competitively priced at a time when pricing and procuring electronic equipment is a highly volatile exercise."

The benefits of TAA compliance extend beyond selling to the U.S. federal government and agencies, including through the GSA (General Services Administration). Transparent supply chains lower the risk of sourcing substandard components and underscores Mimo's commitment to ethical business practices and regulatory standards.

"Stabilizing the availability of Mimo products and solutions for the long term is a core value of the business," said Greg Topel, Chief Growth Officer at Mimo. "This operational
